THE FRANZEN'S CONTRIBUTIONS TO DODGEVILLE, WISCONSIN (USA)

James: Jim Franzen was a significant contributor to the success of Dodgeville, Wisconsin in the Twenty-Century, It all started in 1968 when Jim was transferred to Dodgeville to open-up Dick's Supermarket. In 1968, Dodgeville had four other Grocery Stores in Town (Red Owl, Kroger, Piggly Wiggly and a small retailer.) Jim managed Dick's for 26 years to become the #1 Grocery Store in Iowa county by 1972. Jim Franzen was also the #1 Store Manager consistently relative to Profit contributions vs. other Dick's locations. This excellent and sustainable leadership lead to the creation of the new Spring Gate Mail built in 1981, at the time the only Mail in Iowa County. Without Jim's excellent leadership and consistently being the most profitable store in the Dick's chain made Spring Gate Mail Dodgeville Residents, and Iowa County Residents. This retail grocery store that Jim Franzen built from the ground up is still operational today in the year 2021 under a different Banner. Jim was also a Little League Baseball coach for five years. He was a volunteer Cub Scout Leader for four years. He was a volunteer Fireman for close to a decade. He was prior Lions Club President. A member of the Chamber of Commence. He was a 4th Degree Knights of Columbus via St. Joes in Dodgeville. He was also a major sponsor via his employer of the Dodgeville Home Talent Baseball Team. Jim, over the decades became the biggest and most consistent ad sponsor via Dick's of Dodgeville High School venues. He was also Parish Council Member of St. Joes and volunteered countless hours to St. Joes. Also Named Loins Club Man-of-The-Year. Jim Franzen was also instrumental relative to Dodgeville Charities and volunteer work supplied.

Lands' End: In early 1977, Gary Comer contacted Jim Franzen to arrange a lunch meeting to discuss Dodgeville, the workforce in Dodgeville, and a vast array of other key topics relating to Dodgeville. Bary insisted on speaking with Jim Franzen – who he called had boots on the ground in Dodgeville. In 1977, Disk's was the third largest employer in Dodgeville, behind the School District and the County. Mr. Comer explained to Jim Franzen during their first lunch meeting @ A&W that he was seeking a location for his business. Gary was from Chicago and wanted to select a location in SW Wisconsin. He shared with Jim during their meeting that Platteville, Lancaster, Dodgeville and Mt. Horeb were in the running for his new location. Jim Franzen sold Dodgeville's benefits very hard and after two more lunch meetings with Gary Comer, Dodgeville, Wisconsin was soon thereafter selected as the new home of his company, Land End. Jim had a significant impact on Gary's selection as Mr. Comer trusted Jim. Both became very close friends after their lunch meetings. It is very possible to envision Dodgeville without Spring Gate Mall and Lands End. However, it became possible due to one man's incredible contributions to the success of Dodgeville, Wisconsin. Thanks Jim Franzen for your remarkable contributions to the residents of Dodgeville, Wisconsin and Iowa County.

Patrick: Significant contributor to Conference High School Basketball Championship Team and WIAA Regional High School Championship representing Dodgeville High School. Awarded 7 Varity Letters in High School. Multiple years as volunteer Head Coach for Little League Baseball Teams / Won Championship one Year. Multiple years of work umpiring Little League Baseball as a Volunteer. Employed for close to ten years at Dick's Supermarket contributing to Dick's becoming the #1 Grocery Retailer in Iowa County. Worked two years in Dodgeville as a full-time Wisconsin State Journal contractor. For two years, Patrick serviced over 90 residential customers to ensure they received their paper prior to 6:00 AM - seven days a week. Represented Dodgeville High School as a Student Athlete at two Wisconsin Universities (UW-Richland & UW-Platteville) Close to a 40-Year Corporate Management Career in the Consumer Product Goods Industry. Fortune 500 Award Winning Manager. As a corporate manager, Patrick was even able to hire a prior Dodgeville High School Classmate with Campbell Soup Co (Phil Herimel) Founded Proactive Publishing in 2003. Daniel's business for five years straight was the #1 Top-Selling Pre-Owned Vehicle Dealership in the Tri-County Market. Currently, Daniel has over three decades experience in the transportation industry owning his own company.

Daniel was also employed for over 8 years at Dick's Supermarket as a valued employee towards helping Dick's become the #1 Grocery Retailer in Iowa County. In 1994, Daniel founded in Dodgeville a Transportation Company with 11 (Trucks & Trailers) for National OTR servicing 28 States, employing (8 FT & 4 PT) employees from Iowa County. In 1995, Daniel started another business, as his business was focused on Land Development. His company purchased land in Blue Monuds, WI and created a Residential Development that now has 24 homes in the year 2021. Daniel also gave of his time as he delivered multiple presentations to students at Dodgeville High School and various Dodgeville Clubs (i.e. Loins Club & Chamber of Commence, among others) relative to success as a Entrepreneur. Dodgeville, Wisconsin had not witnessed such success of this level prior, or since from a 30 year-old. Daniel achieved all the aforementioned successful new business developments by the age of 30, only 12 years removed from Dodgeville High School.
