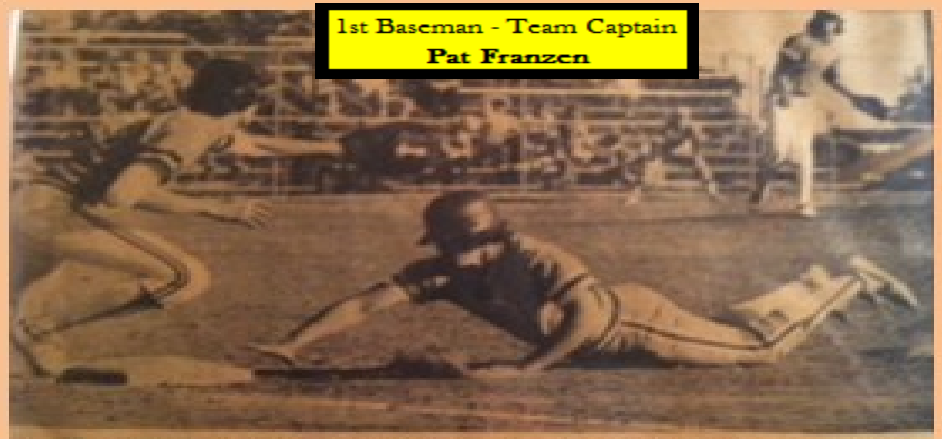

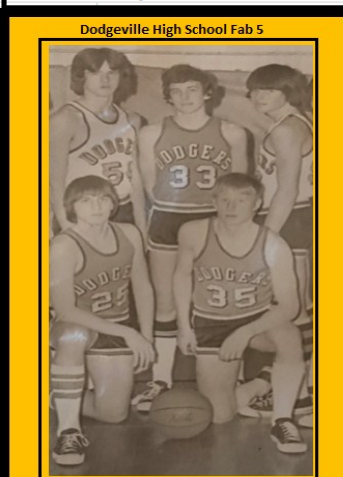


The Fab 5 competed in the Southern 8 Conference in the late seventies as the Southern 8 was one of the most competitive Basketball Class B Conferences in the State.
